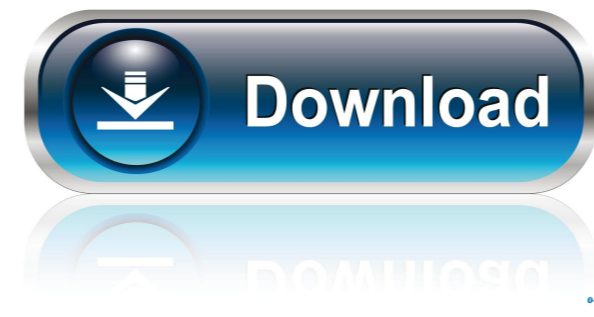

I'd recommend moving to a supported Ubuntu version. |eol End-Of-Life is when security updates and support for an Ubuntu release stop. Make sure to update Ubuntu before it goes EOL so you get updates promptly for newly-discovered security vulnerabilities. See and for more info. Looking to upgrade from an EOL release?
